PBIS is a research-based framework for teaching and supporting positive behavior for ALL students. This school-wide approach focuses on building a safe and positive environment in which all students can learn.

- Clear & consistent expectations for behaviors across all school settings
- Explicitly teaching of expected behavior the same way we teach academic skills
- Frequent praise for expected behaviors
- Common language used by all staff
- Safe learning environment to promote academic success

### Staff will...

Provide a consistent response

Remind & reteach the expectations

Model the expected behavior

Acknowledge behavior change

Communicate & partner with families

Increase levels of support as needed

Ways to partner with us to support your child...

- Discuss our school-wide expectations and how they relate to your expectations at home
- Talk to your child about their day
- Praise your child when you see them doing what they need to do
- Be clear in the expectations you have for their behavior in different settings
- Expect mistakes and have a plan for how you will respond
- Set family routines to build consistency
- Model the social behaviors you would like to see from your child
- Encourage open communication with your child's teacher(s)
