We are pleased to inform you Creekside will be participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) program for the 2020-2021 School Year. The CEP program is part of the National School Lunch and Special Breakfast Programs that provides students access to free, healthy breakfasts and lunches. This program includes a full meal. Second meals, a la carte meals or a la carte milk are not covered under the program.

All enrolled students at Creekside are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at no charge to you or your household, every day of the 2020-2021 school year. Your child(ren) with a primary enrollment at Creekside will be able to participate without having submit a free and reduced meal application.
