





You can only take Spanish 1B if you have completed Spanish 1A with a C or higher at our school or from a school you are moving/coming from.

We use online assessments as well as reviews to help stimulate learning in different ways. We have a multi-sensory approach with visual cues, auditory aids, and movement in every activity. Students will learn targeted grammatical phrases & concepts, thematic vocabulary, and cultural appreciation.

This is a yearlong class where students learn what is taught in the second semester of freshmen year (9th gr) in high school. Students go more in-depth with verbs and reading and writing longer paragraphs working towards stories. They have a STAMP test that students must take at the end of the year along with completing the course with a 70 % or higher in order to receive high school credit for Spanish I. Spanish I is not Pre-AP Spanish. By the end of this course, students will be expected to describe people, objects, places, make simple explanations, identify their preferences, give their likes and dislikes, move from word and phrase level to communicating in sentences, give and opinion or preference with simple supporting statements and use double verb constructions to offer alternatives or show intent. Spanish 1B prepare students for a successful transition to Spanish II.
