


What is the biggest hurdle you faced in your first five weeks?



What is your most challenging course?





Are you confident you will pass all your classes with a "C" or better?

Are you aware of resources available to students in need of academic support?






Who/what has been most helpful resource to you in your first 5 weeks?





- •Turning on camera in Zoom is a common courtesy


- More clarification on JR vs SR college prep sessions
