From our Taku Family to yours, we wish you a wonderful holiday season filled with love, laughter, and special moments. Thank you for your continued partnership and support.



Dear Families,

This letter is to let you know that your child's class will be receiving age-appropriate lessons on child sexual abuse and assault prevention education as required under the state's <u>Alaska Safe</u> <u>Children's Act</u> (<u>Erin's Law</u>).

Erin's Law Education is comprised of two lessons (one lesson at the beginning of each semester) taught during the Health classes.



Combined, these lessons meet the full requirements for students under the <u>Alaska Safe Children's</u> <u>Act</u> (<u>Erin's Law</u>) and are designed to help prevent childhood sexual abuse. These lessons will be presented in a non-threatening way, along with the skills needed for self-protection and will be handled in a sensitive, respectful manner.


