Beginning in the 2018-19 school year, Martin Luther King, Jr. Career Center (KCC) rebranded into Martin Luther King, Jr. Technical High School (King Tech) by adding full-time students. This marked a turning point in our 44-year history. King Tech is now a full-time school for ASD juniors and seniors that combines career technical education with regular core classes in a design-your-own-education format. Now a fully accredited high school, we proudly graduate students from King Tech.

Blended Model Academics

King Tech full-time students choose a $\frac{1}{2}$ day CTE to anchor their schedules. Some students will follow a pathway within a particular career cluster while others may choose to explore various pathways. The other half of the day is spent in a blended model presentation of academic courses individualized for students to meet their graduation requirements.
