Be it resolved by Operational Group, that Polaris K-12 will implement naming a Valedictorian and Salutatorian of every senior class.

- 1. **Whereas**, A Valedictorian is "a student, typically having the highest academic achievements of the class, who delivers the valedictory at a graduation ceremony";
- 2. **Whereas**, A Salutatorian is "the student who ranks second highest in a graduating class and delivers the salutatory"²;
- 3. Whereas, Polaris K-12 does not currently have Valedictorian or Salutatorian recognition;
- 4. Whereas, Other schools in ASD have the Valedictorian and a Salutatorian recognition;
- 5. Whereas, Being Valedictorian or Salutatorian would be a great thing to put on your resume;
- 6. Whereas, the Valedictorian and Salutatorian will be decided on students' weighted GPAs.
- 7. **Whereas**, Polaris K-12 already has a place system per High School class, adding the Valedictorian and Salutatorian achievement would further recognize the students academic achievements and GPA; and
- 8. **Whereas**, Past Polaris students recognition was lost because there is no Valedictorian and Salutatorian recognition currently in place;

Therefore, be it resolved by Operational Group, that Polaris K-12 will implement naming a Valedictorian and Salutatorian of every senior class.
