ART COURSE REUIREMENTS:

Art 1:

This is an integrated study of the visual arts. The major areas of study are drawing, painting, printmaking, sculpture and art metals. Each quarter is presented in an order to develop design concepts, use of media, art history, self-expression and criticism.

Art Studio:

This is a general exploratory course with a strong emphasis on the elements and principles of design. A variety of art processes and media, i.e., drawing, lettering, printmaking, painting, fiber, layout, jewelry, sculpture, and art appreciation will be introduced.

The student will submit four work samples per semester. Student work should reflect intentional study of 90 hours of one or more mediums of art. The following list includes examples of work samples that may be submitted:

- Photos of completed artwork
- An essay with a focus of art history
- A portfolio of student work
- Documentation of student goals and a reflection on the student's goal progress during the semeste
- A log of hours
- Awards received for art competition, etc.
- Written assignments about art history or art technique
- Reflection on a news article about art
